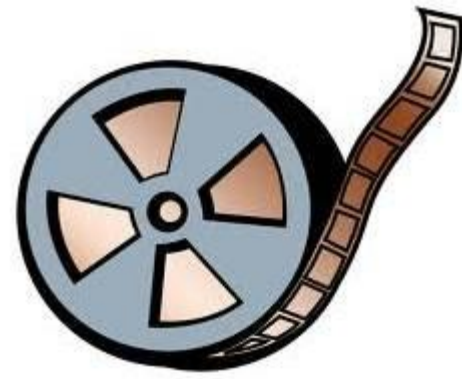


Adults' Social Group
