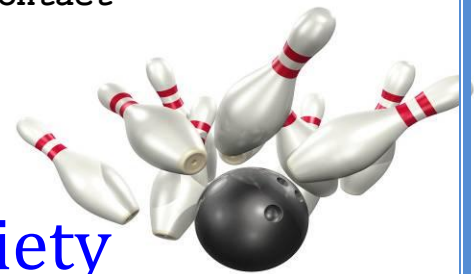


Young Person's Social Group

- The Teenager's Group is a social group for young people between the ages of 15 to 20 with an ASD.
- There are two teenager's Social Groups - one meets monthly on a Monday from 3pm-5pm the other meets every two weeks on a Tuesday evening from 6pm-8pm.
- Both groups meet under the clock in Central Station.
- The group can be used to socialise, meet people, participate in new activities, improve your social skills, and increase your confidence.
- The group is free to join - but group members pay for the planned activity.
- The group participates in a variety of social activities including bowling, meals, cinema, laser planet, speedboats, pool and more...

- The group is staffed by three fully Disclosed support workers.
