The **(AKS) Self-Assessment and Training Action Plan** has been designed to assist individual staff members or service managers to record training needs when using the NES Autism Training Framework: Optimising Outcomes and the **NES Autism Training Plan.** To use the Self Assessment sheet:-

- Familiarise yourself with the 3 areas and the 4 levels in the NES Autism Training Framework (pp.12-15)
- Familiarise yourself with the training considerations in the NES Autism Training Plan (pp.10 -11)
- Begin with *Identification, Screening, Assessment & Diagnosis* (pp. 18-19). Identify the level for yourself or your team (for managers)
- Go to the relevant page and look through the tables identified for your level. Consider the information in the Knowledge and Skills columns. How confident do you feel in relation to the core knowledge and skills required at your level?
- Now repeat for: Management, Support & Intervention (pp. 52-53) and Autism across the lifespan: Transitions and change (pp.74-75)
- Complete the AKS-Self-Assessment.
